Here's a cheat sheet of 10 things, you should NEVER flush down the toilet:

- HAIR** - hair clogs showers, sinks, and toilets by forming into giant clumps and creating massive blockages in pipes, plumbing, and sewers.
- DENTAL FLOSS** - It's not biodegradable and similar to hair, eventually tangles together into clumps and clogs pipes.
- FAT, OILS & GREASE** - They may go in as liquid but they cool, harden, and build up on the sides of your pipes making the opening smaller and smaller.
- BAND AIDS** - They are not biodegradable, even the felt ones, so they belong in the trash.
- PAPER TOWELS** - The only type of paper that should be flushed down the toilet is toilet paper.
- MEDICATION** - The water in your toilet is water that ends up in our rivers, lakes, and oceans. Old, expired, and unused medications will contaminate the water.
- DISPOSABLE WIPES** - While they may be called disposable they are NOT flushable, even the ones that claim you can flush them. They cause chaos in sewer and septic systems.
- CONTRACEPTIVES AND PROPHYLACTICS** - Also not biodegradable. They will clog pipes and drains so throw them in the trash.
- KITTY LITTER** - Dispose kitty litter in the trash. The litter will clump and harden if poured down the drain.
- FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS** - They are notorious for clogging pipes, pumps, and drains.

None of these items should ever be poured down a drain, dumped into a storm sewer, or a sanitary sewer. You can help protect the environment, wastewater treatment equipment, and the people who operate our treatment facilities by doing your part to dispose of your waste properly. So remember to reduce, reuse, and recycle whenever possible.

Aquí hay una hoja de referencia de 10 cosas que NUNCA debe tirar por el inodoro:

- PELO** - El pelo obstruye las duchas, los lavabos y los inodoros formándose en grupos gigantes y creando obstrucciones masivas en tuberías, plomería y alcantarillas.
- HILO DENTAL** - No es biodegradable y como el pelo, eventualmente se enreda en grumos y obstruye las tuberías.
- MANTECA, ACEITE Y GRASA** - Pueden entrar en forma líquida, pero se enfrían, endurecen y se acumulan en los lados de las tuberías, lo que hace que la abertura sea cada vez más pequeña.
- CURITAS** - No son biodegradables, ni siquiera los de filtro, por lo que pertenecen a la basura.
- TOALLAS DE PAPEL** - El único tipo de papel que se debe tirar por el inodoro es el papel higiénico.
- MEDICAMENTO** - El agua de su inodoro es agua que termina en nuestros ríos, lagos y océanos. Los medicamentos viejos, vencidos y sin usar contaminarán el agua.
- TOALLITAS DESECHABLES** - Si bien pueden llamarse desechables, NO se pueden tirar por el inodoro, ni siquiera los nuevos que afirman que puede tirarlos. Causan caos en los sistemas de alcantarillado y sépticos.
- ANTICONCEPTIVOS Y PROFILÁCTICOS** - Además, no es biodegradable. Obstruirán tuberías y desagües, así que tírelos a la basura.
- ARENA PARA GATOS** - Deseche la arena para gatos en la basura. La arena se aglomera y se endurece o se vierte por el desagüe.
- PRODUCTOS DE HIGIENE FEMENINA** - Son conocidos por obstruir tuberías, bombas y desagües.

Ninguno de estos artículos se debe tirar por un desagüe, en un alcantarillado pluvial o en un alcantarillado sanitario. Puede ayudar a proteger el medio ambiente, los equipos de tratamiento de aguas residuales y las personas que operan nuestras instalaciones de tratamiento haciendo su parte para eliminar sus desechos de manera adecuada. Así que recuerde reducir, reutilizar y reciclar siempre que sea posible.
