ADDENDUM #3 TO RFP #2020-004 – Fire & EMS Services

To All Prospective Proposers,

Please be advised that the following question(s) have been received in response to RFP #2020-004–Fire & EMS Services. In response to these questions, we are issuing this official Addendum.

1. What is the current Insurance Services Office (ISO) rating for the Village of Indiantown?

ISO Class Rating -3

2. Will the response time historical data for 5 years be available? Information to include: Date of response, call type, response address or geocode, transport status for Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Advanced Life Support (ALS) or Basic Life Support (BLS).

No, we do not have a 5-year summary of historical data. We do have a 1-year analysis of response activities, which is provided. (See Attached)

3. Does the Village have a fleet maintenance facility that could provide vehicle maintenance and repairs at an agreed to rate for provider?

No, the Village does not operate a fleet maintenance facility.

4. Will the response to hazardous incidents be at an operations level or technician level? Will there be any technician or higher-level response and mitigation required for incidents involving confined space rescue, technical water rescue, trench rescue, or high elevation/rope rescue? Is there a county or state resource that provides for any technician level specialty response?

Hazardous Materials Response should be provided at the operations level. There are multiple higher-level specialized response capabilities that are available through mutual aid provisions at the local and regional levels.

5. Has the Village of Indiantown adopted Florida State Fire Prevention Code in its entirety? What edition is currently adopted? Are there any local amendments applicable to Indiantown?

The Village is currently using the 2017 Florida Fire Prevention Code. It is using the Martin County Fire Code as its transitional code. (See Attached)

6. Does this section only pertain to ambulance transport financial records?

Yes, only EMS financial reporting is required under this provision.

7. Is the funding of Martin County Sheriff's Office Communications Unit and Martin County Fire Rescue Communications through State and County Shared revenue streams, or will the allocated use/cost by Indiantown/Provider need to be funded through this proposal?

The cost for dispatch services will be provided by Martin County SO and MCFR and these services will be provided at no cost to the Provider.

8. Is there a designated representative identified?

The Village Clerk is the sole point of contact <u>for this RFP</u>. The day-to-day representative for the awardee is yet to be determined; however, it will NOT be the village Clerk.

9. Is the in-person attendance of this meeting mandatory?

The requirement for mandatory participation at the pre-bid conference has been waived because of the Coronavirus outbreak.

10. A handout showing location of existing fire station was obtained with proposed site plan for additional structures. Can a copy of fire stations floor plan and the temp trailer floorplan be obtained?

A floorplan for the fire station is attached. The placement of additional buildings is conceptual, and this determination has not been finalized. (See Attached)

11. Are there any other village owned properties that could be used/leased to provide for alternative station locations?

The Village owns vacant properties, generally open space or park areas. These are vacant lands that could be built upon as an alternative fire station site. The Village also owns a vacant 1.0-acre parcel immediately adjacent on the east side of the Booker Park Fire Station. This parcel could be used for immediate expansion if necessary.
