Finance

There are no new updates for the Finance Department. The following highlights below will be ongoing projects for the next few months.

- Working with audit consulting contractor on planning and preparation for FY22 Audit.
- Staff is currently reviewing the Budget for Fiscal Year 23/Planning and preparation for the FY23-24 Budget Cycle.
- We are also currently completing a rate study on water and sewer rates.
- Tyler Technology software implementation is forthcoming.

- **Fiscal Year 23 State Appropriation Funding- Funding Amount \$550,000**
 - Lincoln Street Roadway and Drainage Project (Approved)
- **Fiscal Year 24 Mast Appropriations- Funding Amount \$4,000,000**
 - 151st and Osceola Street Water Main Project
- **EPA Brownfields Grant**
 - Through the funding obtained in the USEPA FY22 Brownsfields Assessment Grant, the TCRPC has a unique opportunity to assist the Village as it formulates a vision for its focus area, the Booker Park neighborhood. The proposed project will assist in capturing the community vision through a public engagement program. We are working on scheduling the next community meeting and contacting stakeholders.
- **Thriving Communities Grant Program**
 - Once the Technical Assistance provider (Main Street America) contacts the Village, the next steps will be for them to work closely to develop a work plan and complete a technical assessment of the Village community streets.

- Kimley-Horn has finished Design for the Water Treatment Plant, and is out to Bid, all bids are due Friday June 23, 2023.
- Jonathon Pablo and Rafael Sanchez are participating in the Florida Rural Water Association Apprenticeship program, which will help them obtain certification.
- Jaime Andres and Pat Nolan has renewed our Water and Wastewater certification.
- Our newest employee, Megan Levering has started in the Utilities department.
- PRP Construction has completed Storm Drainage repairs on Johnston, Yalaha, and Shawnee.
- Planning for the SW Lincoln Street project will now begin, since we have received funding.





COMING SOON

Business Services and Economic Development



Highlights

- The Village Staff is coordinating with the Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council and its consultant, Stantec, to consider the preparation of a Brownsfield Redevelopment Plan for part of the Booker Park neighborhood. A Brownsfield is a land area that may have been impacted by environmental pollution in the past. This plan would be funded by a grant from the Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council in Stuart. A second Community Workshop in Booker Park has yet to be finalized.
- The Booker Park Swamp Fest 2023 is scheduled for June 23-25, 2023, at Booker Park, 15101 SW 169th Avenue. This event is sponsored by the Concerned Citizens for Booker Park.
- The Indiantown Chamber of Commerce will be holding the Independence Day Heritage Festival on Saturday, July 1, 2023, from 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. at Timers Powers Park, 21479 SW Citrus Boulevard.
- A Certificate of Use was issued to Rosalba Contreras to allow an office for Affordable Insurance of Martin County at 15305 East Thelma Waters Avenue.


