Water & Wastewater Utilities Public Works



On Friday, November 17, 2023, staff and contractors responded to a water main break at the corner of MLK and Farm Road where an 8-inch water main was hit causing an immediate drop in pressure throughout the Village. Utility Staff and Contractors worked diligently to repair the break and restore water service as quickly as they could, which was around 7:00 PM. A boil water advisory was issued and 2 rounds of samples were taken to the lab until were confirmed good. Advisory was lifted on Tuesday, November 21, 2023.

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
